

To all West Virginia SNAP households:

In response to COVID-19, the WV DHHR will issue emergency supplemental allotments to all existing SNAP households for the month(s) of April and May 2020. Eligible SNAP households are those who were approved for SNAP prior to the first day of April or May. This supplement will give the household the maximum SNAP benefit for their household size. The additional SNAP amount will be the difference between your regular monthly SNAP amount and the maximum benefit amount for your household size. Please see the maximum benefit table below.

Example: A 2-person household who regularly received \$200 per month in SNAP is eligible for an emergency supplemental allotment. The maximum benefit amount for a 2-person household is \$355. This SNAP household is entitled to a \$155 supplement ($355 - 200 =$ emergency allotment).

Household Size	Maximum benefit
1	\$194
2	\$355
3	\$509
4	\$646
5	\$768
6	\$921
7	\$1018

You do not have to come to your local DHHR or call The Office of Constituent Services to access this additional benefit. Also, you will not be required to complete any forms or applications to receive the supplement.

ALL ACTIVE SNAP CASES WILL RECEIVE A SUPPLEMENT, UNLESS YOUR HOUSEHOLD IS ALREADY RECEIVING THE MAXIMUM BENEFIT.
